## THE PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

August is coming! And with it come hotter temperatures, schools start back up, people returning from summer vacation adventures, and the rhythm of the town get a little more exciting. Teachers prep their rooms for their students, parents prep their kids for school, and First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) preps for their new Fiscal year. The Congregational Planning committee brought with it ideas and energies, and for all of those who participated, many thanks.

We are part of a church, striving to be ONE (which was the theme of the General Assembly) – "a movement for wholeness in a fragmented world." And our church represents that struggle, perhaps, to a stronger degree than some areas. Being a "liberal" church in a "conservative" state has its challenges. How do we make sure everyone feels welcome, when there are precious souls involved? How do we make sure that we grow together as ONE body, when we are so diverse?

Luckily, this has been our spoken truth and goal since the inception of this Denomination. We have a truly worthy history of mission, education, empowering the laity, and focus on the word. We empower and embody the Word of God when we strive to know those around us more fully. ALL of those around us, not just those we are comfortable with. This is what makes us one ~ talking about our faith, learning about each other, hearing and sharing our lives with each other so that we may know Christ more fully. And with the power of Christ we can serve as he taught us, better.

From our new (and historic) General Minister and President, Rev. Teresa (Terri) Hord Owens: "Jesus' prayer for unity is not to establish "kum-ba-yah" moments, "feel good" experiences that evaporate after we release our neighbor's hand. Jesus' intent and vision is that we are one "so that the world may know that you have sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me." (John 17:23b, NRSV). Our striving for unity is perhaps the most powerful way in which we bear witness that the love of God is real and present in the world. If we can hold one another in community, even in the presence of tensions that result from human differences of various dimensions of identity, socio-economic status, geography, theology and politics, it should be our goal that the world will see in us what is possible through Christian love and unity. We can be an example to the world to say that we believe the gospel of Jesus Christ and his church are so important that we can work together despite those differences to ensure that God's message of love is shared and lived out in the world, as we work for justice for all. This is, I believe, what Jesus prayed for, and it is what I believe we are called to live out as disciples/Disciples of Christ."

This is our calling, to open our lives up to accepting more and more people and to let everyone know we are people of God living through Grace. We are ONE with each other and with Christ when we live with each other, not as we would live, but as Christ would love.




## **CHOIR and BELLS**
