As we enter this time of Advent, we share in a time to preparing our hearts, our homes, our church, and our lives for the coming of the Christ. We know the birth is coming, but we intentionally observe a time of waiting: waiting with expectation for the promises of God's peace to be fulfilled; anticipating the hope of new life, not just in a baby, but in the realm of righteousness and justice for all; and seeking a future that will bring the joy of God's reconciling love into our world.

In this season of Advent, FCC is experiencing a unique sense of waiting and expectation as the church continues it's search for its next senior minister. The anticipation of the waiting is both exciting and difficult. Yet, in the mysterious timing of God's spirit, the efforts and discernment of the Search Committee are being matched with the discernment of some very special clergyperson who is, in this very moment, discerning a sense of calling to a new ministry in their lives as well. Waiting in hope, we continue to keep both sides of this process in our hearts and prayer.

In the meantime, my time with you is drawing to a close. Due to previous plans my husband and I have starting in January of 2017 because of his Sabbatical from Transylvania, Sunday, December 25 will be my last service with you. While the timing of my departure didn't match perfectly with a smooth transition into the hiring of your next senior minister, rest assured plans have been made for the church to move forward with ministerial assistance in the new year.

The following is my letter of resignation, which I offered to the Executive Board at their November 28 meeting. Behind the words on this page, however, my heart is full to overflowing with love for each one of you, and gratitude for the wonderful way you have welcomed me as part of your community of faith. You will always be in my thoughts and prayers, and I will eagerly be waiting and watching the progress you make as the pathway to your future journey of faith and ministry emerges. That said:

"It is with deep regret that I tender my resignation as Interim Minister at First Christian Church in Morehead. Per my conversations with the Executive Board, Christmas Sunday, December 25, 2016 will be my last official day, with the remainder of the month taken as vacation time.

Over the past 17 months, it has been my sincerest pleasure to serve the congregation and share in its witness to the community of Morehead, and beyond. It has been a true blessing getting to know, and coming to love, the members and staff of this congregation through worship, fellowship, and service.

As you continue the search for the church's next minister, it is my fervent prayer that the church will be able to find the ideal candidate whose gifts and talents will help lead you into your future.

May God bless you all and the future ministries and missions this church so profoundly believes in as their calling in service to Christ and his reconciling love.



PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE




