

A REQUEST FROM SHARON DENHAM: Sharon is in the midst of an important study. She is working in 11 Appalachian counties in four different states to strengthen diabetes coalitions and do work that is aimed at the prevention of type 2 diabetes. (You can see more about her work at http:// appalachianphilanthropy.org/diabetes/index.htmlShe is asking each participating church to identify a 'health committee' of 3 persons to attend the training session. They will then take what they have learned back to their churches and involve others in ways they believe will be most fitting. At the training session, committees will receive information several local and national diabetes education programs. They will also be given a number of other resources to take back to their churches to plan their own activities. The changes people need to make most are lifestyle changes... You do not have to be a health professional to champion these efforts.
