CHOIR NOTES

As I sit down to write this month's column, I am feeling a bit reflective. Change tends to bring this on I think, and we've had quite a bit of that! With the choir on summer hiatus, I thought I might share with you a few of my favorite hymn tunes. I hope you enjoy learning about them — and if they're new to you maybe you'll want to check out a recording online!

I was first introduced to *St. Clements* about 17 years ago when I was working with an Episcopal church in Maysville. I went to a summer conference and one of the evenings that week we had an Evensong service. The opening hymn was entitled *The Day Thou Gavest, Lord, Is Ended*. And that particular tune, sung around sunset, in a lovely chapel, with an amazing organist and chancel choir... well, you get the idea. It was awe-inspiring and I still remember the moment with clarity.

Now, there's not much call for a hymn about the end of the day in Sunday morning worship, no matter how lovely, so this is not a hymn that is sung very often. However, the wonderful thing about hymn tunes is that many times they have more than one setting – and so it is with *St. Clements*!

In our hymnal, the title of the setting is *O Breath of Life*. It's a charming set of text written in 1920 by a lady named Bessie Porter Head. I like to think perhaps she heard the hymn tune somewhat like I did and was inspired by its loveliness to write the text so it could be used more often and not only for Evensong.
