### MERRYMENTS: Part II—Abstain, Add, and Encounter

For all who are practicing a discipline of abstinence or addition during this Lenten season, there is an encouraging word: this experience is not really about successfully getting through Lent without "cheating," as in when we couldn't resist that piece of chocolate, or "forgetting," when we really meant to get up early for that morning meditation but forgot to set the alarm. It is more about the experience and intentionality of being attentive, faithful, and mindful when it comes to going about our daily routines with an awareness of God's presence in our lives.



During Lent we, as Christians, are striving to gain a deeper relationship with God's love and grace in our lives. This effort often leads us to be more open to the many ways we encounter God every day. Perhaps God "showed up" in the voice of a friend on the other end of a phone call. Maybe God "showed up" as you listened to a beautiful song or musical piece. Could God have been in that word of encouragement or prayer of support we received from our neighbor? Perhaps in the unexpected smile of a stranger that lifted us up in that brief moment so as to see the face of God in that smile?

On our Lenten journey to Holy Week, may we all discover that the finite cry we will hear from the cross, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" is ultimately replaced with the infinite ways God "shows up" in our lives every day, if we but have faith in the mystery and miracle of God's resurrection presence. The victory over death and despair in the resurrection of Jesus as our Lord and Savior is as much a gift of God's active love for us each day of our lives as it is an eternal promise for our future. May we, as a church family, discover such moments of grace for ourselves and with one another, even if without knowing it, we become that special encounter for each other and for the world when God, in and through us, "shows up."

#### **Nominating Committee**

Each year our church calls into order a Nominating Committee, comprised of 1 elder, 2 deacons, and 3 members at large. The function of this committee is to fill necessary positions within the church board – officers and deacons. (It also presents the name of any new elders which need to be nominated, but those are gathered within the elder board, and that does not happen each year.) This is done through a system of gathering names from within the congregation. Anyone who has been a church member for the 12 months prior to the new church year (which begins on 1 July) may be considered. Slips for suggesting possible names are available at each door of the sanctuary, and on this page.

It is to be hoped that many of you will – with prayer and discernment – think about those around you who would be good additions to our working Board. Officers are also elected each year. **The deacon co-chairs determine how many new deacons need to be added to the roster, which consists of a term of three years on, one year of sabbatical.** 

It is the job of the Nominating Committee to count the names on the slips AND TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THOSE WHO ARE NOMINATED. The 2016-2017 Nominating Committee: Susan Thomas, chair; Carmen Swim, Holly Pollock, Betty Hall, Mike Seelig, and Joyce Hart. Please be in prayer for them as they work and serve our larger church.

NOMINATION SLIPS NEED TO BE TURNED IN BY MARCH 13 a basket is available in front of the sanctuary chalice in which to place the slips, or you may drop them in the offering plate or mail them to the office.

Our Nominating Committee is working on the 2016-2019 rotation of deacons. They ask you to join them in prayer and discernment as this process unfolds. **Only church members may be nominated.** The slate will be presented to the board at the March meeting for approval; then the slate will be published in the ECHO and the bulletin so that the congregation may know the names. The slate will be voted on by the congregation at the May annual meeting.


