Season of Lent begins February 14

Soon the church year transitions into Lent, a season of preparation for the celebration of Holy Week and Easter. The roots of the word "Lent" are in the old English word, "lenten" meaning "lengthen" and relatedly, "spring." It draws from the northern hemisphere's experience of the coming of spring, the lengthening of sunlight hours, and the promises of new life the spring brings each year.

Early church practices included the preparation of candidates for baptism in the six weeks leading up to Easter. Over time the entire church community would come alongside those baptismal candidates, reflecting on their own baptism through the 40 days of Lent. The Lenten practices of fasting and prayer created a communal bond and common focus.

This Lent we will be exploring this idea of lengthening during Lent.

How does our experiences of the lengthening of time expand our understanding of Christ's call to abundant living? How can these days broaden our spiritual journey? What gifts do these days of preparation hold for us?



Anyone interested in baptism or in exploring the big questions of life and faith, contact Pastor Nancy for more information.




Women's 2024 Bible Study Weekly Discussions based on *Core 52* by Mark E. Moore
